

Short Description of the Bordelon's Garden

"Shortly after we moved into our current home in 1989, we started to develop our gardens on our quarter acre suburban lot. As our back garden was ideal for shade loving plants, we planted a variety of flowering shrubs, perennials and groundcovers which have matured over the years. Moss paths with stepping stones line the garden beds. In the center of the garden is a small pond and sitting area. Recent additions include a flagstone patio ideal for sitting and enjoying an outdoor fire and drainage work to mitigate the runoff from heavy rains.

Other features of the back garden include a greenhouse, a wrap around screened porch and several small raised beds used for growing vegetables.

The main feature of the front is a tufa rock garden, various conifers and assorted sun loving perennials. The majority of the plants are deer resistant and tolerate dry conditions due to a large maple tree on the edge of the property"
